

Installing your Décor Windows

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:

- 1. Verify that your Décor Windows will fit properly on your garage door. (Refer to Coach House Accents® document "Garage Door Specifications" available on our website).
- 2. Place your window onto the garage door where desired, using a tape measure to ensure that the window is positioned properly on the door panels. Drill 1/8-inch holes in the eight locations. **Start with center holes.**
- 3. Lay the window face down on a smooth surface to avoid scratching it, and remove the protective film from the back of the Plexiglass.
- **4**. Insert the eight screws into the mounting holes from the front of the panel, and press the rubber washers onto the screw threads from the back side. Ensure the rubber washers make contact with the surface of the panel.



5. Lift the window up to the door panel, and align the protruding screws to the pilot holes. Tighten the screws to fasten the window to the door. DO NOT OVER-TIGHT EN, which can pull the threads from the holes or distort the panel.

Repeat this process for your other window panels.

Tools required for installation:


- Electric Drill with 1/8" Drill Bit
- Phillips Screwdriver
- Tape Measure
- Level
- Step Stool or Ladder
